

## EUROTARY 87

### NOTES OF THE GENERAL MEETING OF THE 10<sup>TH</sup> ASSEMBLY HELD ON SUNDAY 16 SEPTEMBER 2001 AT THE AVIGNON CITY HALL COMMENCING AT 10:15 AM

1. President Patrice Ripoché of the Rotary Club of Avignon Fontaine de Vaucluse welcomed representatives of 16 Rotary Clubs.
2. Banners were exchanged with the Host Club and some presentations were made.
3. The Minutes of the 9<sup>th</sup> Assembly held at Telford on 17<sup>th</sup> September 2000 were agreed.
4. Matters arising were dealt with as Agenda items.
5. Revised Constitution

The revised Constitution was approved on a proposal by The Wreake Valley seconded by Albrighton and District.

6. The meeting confirmed the acceptance of an invitation by RC The Wreake Valley to host the 11<sup>th</sup> Assembly. Peter Dalton was invited to present the proposals for the 11<sup>th</sup> Assembly following which he presented Information Packs to each delegate.
7. The meeting provisionally accepted an invitation from RC Kolback to host the 12<sup>th</sup> Assembly. Jan Barklund said that it would be fitting to return to Kolback on the tenth anniversary of their last hosting.
8. President Patrice stated that RC Avignon Fontaine de Vaucluse had no proposal for Common Action. Peter Dalton advised the meeting that The Wreake Valley intended to propose to the 11<sup>th</sup> Assembly that Eurotary 87 support *Hope and Homes for Children* and outlined the work that they did and indicated the level of support needed. He suggested that the project could be agreed now and run over a period of two years. This was supported by Rod Bristow of RC Stafford Castle. Jan Barklund of RC Kolback said that because of the size of the project they would support its continuation for a further year during their period of Presidency. After discussion the meeting agreed that the equipping of a *Hope and Homes for Children* Home in Eastern Europe be the Common Action project for the years 2001 – 2003.
9. There was no further business and Peter Dalton, on behalf of those attending, thanked President Patrice and the members of RC Avignon Fontaine de Vaucluse for the wonderful Eurotary 87 weekend and the hospitality that everyone had enjoyed. This was endorsed by the meeting.
