The cost of the bus was £ 17,500 and was within a few pounds of the amount donated by the contributing Clubs of EUROTARY 87 together with the Matching Grant from Rotary Foundation.

Peter Dalton was grateful for the help and support, that EUROTARY 87 and the participating Clubs have given him in fulfilment of the project.

Peter Dalton request the participants in the annual meeting to pass on to the President and the members of the participants Club his grateful appreciation for the financial support, that they have given the project and the encouragement, they have given him along the way.

Item 5: Surprise presentation!!

Item 6: Nicaragua-project by Aage Rønn Christensen, Korsør Nor Rotary Klub.

Some of the meeting participants promised to bring the question for financial support to the Nicaragua project back to the home Clubs.
